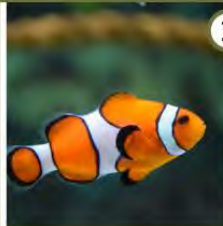

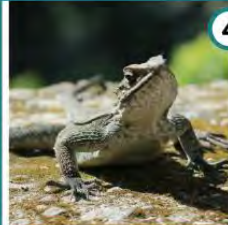

Cuando describimos objetos, animales o personas, utilizamos **adjetivos**. En inglés, los adjetivos se ubican antes del sustantivo, por ejemplo:

beautiful brown eyes

+ SUSTANTIVO

sharp long red tail

ADJETIVO

+ SUSTANTIVO

Recordemos que, para expresar que algo o alguien tiene esas cualidades, usamos el verbo “tener” o *to have*. Entonces, podemos decir que tenemos un animal y que ese animal tiene ciertas cualidades, por ejemplo:

HAVE / HAS

I have a small blue bird

My bird has small eyes and a big colorful tail

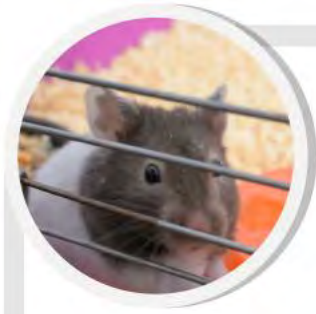
