CULTURAL CORNER

Las estaciones del año tienen condiciones climáticas especiales, pero... **¿son iguales en todos lados?**

Las estaciones varían de acuerdo al lugar del mundo en que nos encontramos, es decir, de acuerdo con el hemisferio en el que estemos. El hemisferio norte y el hemisferio sur aparecen cuando se hace un corte imaginario al planeta justo en la mitad a la altura del ecuador. Las estaciones son opuestas entre los hemisferios: cuando en el hemisferio norte es invierno, en el hemisferio sur es verano. Por ejemplo, cuando en Estados Unidos (hemisferio norte) es invierno (diciembre, enero y febrero), en Argentina (hemisferio sur) es verano; cuando en Inglaterra es primavera (marzo, abril, mayo), en Australia (hemisferio sur) es otoño.

Los cambios a los que nos tiene acostumbrados cada estación **¿se vivirán igual en cada lugar?**

No en todos los países se considera que hay cuatro estaciones. En Alaska, por ejemplo, la gente suele decir que hay tres estaciones: *winter, still winter, and construction season* (invierno, invierno otra vez y temporada de construcción); incluso en algunas partes de la India, tienen seis *ritu* o estaciones según el calendario Hindú: *vasanta* (primavera), *grishma* (verano), *varsha* (lluvia o monzón), *sharat* (otoño), *hemant* (preinvierno) y *shishira* (invierno).




